Today, Knights and their families remain true to these principles and work to spread Columbianism around the world.

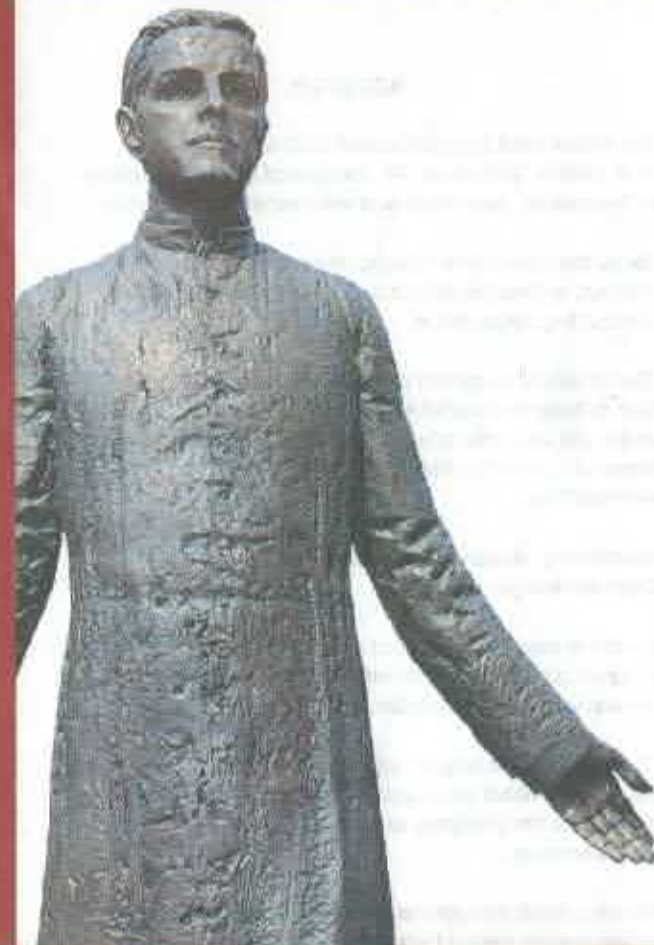
